Statement	<p>Student transportation service may be cancelled from time to time due to inclement weather and/or poor road conditions. In the interest of student safety, when the outside temperature reaches a predetermined extreme cold temperature, student transportation will be cancelled for the day.</p>
Practice	<p>When the outside temperature including wind chill reaches -40 degrees Celsius at 6:00 am, student transportation will be cancelled for the day.</p> <p>Determination and process of the cancellation will be as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ STSTB will monitor the weather conditions and temperatures throughout the night. ➤ If the temperature including wind chill is -40°C or below on the Environment Canada Weather Website (at the Thunder Bay Airport) (http://weather.gc.ca) at 6:00 am, student transportation will be cancelled for the day. ➤ All factors are to be considered before the cancellation of student transportation. (eg. Weather forecast for the day, the duration of the cold temperatures) ➤ The decision to close schools for the day is the responsibility of the individual member school boards. ➤ STSTB will contact the Transportation Managers of the member school boards and inform them of the decision to cancel.
